To help prepare students for post secondary high school life, transition services are a mandatory aspect of the IEP. Agencies may be invited to help facilitate the child's movement from school to post-school activities, including postsecondary education: vocational education: integrated employment (including supported employment): continuing and adult education; adult services; independent living or community participation.
